Notice of Formation of Work Group for Review of Underground Storage Tank Leak **Detection** Equipment/Procedures Eval uat i ons

By now, most of you have heard of our work group, which was put together for the purpose of reviewing leak detection equipment/procedures evaluations. However, we have come to realize that you need to know more about the work group so you can better understand why we are requesting information concerning the evaluations you have performed on your leak detection equipment/procedures and what we intend to do with the information you send us.

Let me begln by providing some history behind the formation of the work group. Soon after leak detection equipment/procedures were required to be evaluated to prove its capability to meet EPA leak detection performance requirements, some states began to take a hard look at how the evaluations were performed instead of accepting the results at face value, The states reviewing these evaluations found most to be well done, but a few that were not properly tested in accordance with EPA Standard Test Procedures. Many other states expressed interest in these findings, but did not have the resources and/or expertise to review the evaluations themselves. At this point an effort was made to consolidate state and EPA expertise and resources in a work group for the purpose of reviewing leak detection equipment/procedures evaluations.

The resulting work group consists of 7 states, 2 EPA regions, and EPA's Office of Underground Storage Tanks (see attached member list). It is divided up into teams (see attached team list) which perform a detalled review of leak detection evaluation results, test data, calculations, test protocols, operating procedures, etc. in order to accomplish the fallowing mission as established by the members of the work group.

The **mission** of the work group Is to review release detection equipment/procedures evaluations to determine if each evaluation was performed In accordance with an acceptable protocol, to ensure that the equipment/procedures meet EPA performance standards.
